

SECTION XII

PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

The following "Player Code of Conduct" has been adopted by the Campbell County Parks and Recreation Department's Adult Sports Program. These rules of conduct will be strictly enforced during each season. It is the captains responsibility to ensure all his/her players know and adhere to these rules.

1. **NO PLAYER SHALL:** At any time lay a hand upon, shove, strike or threaten an official. Officials are required to immediately suspend the individual from further play, and report such player to the League Director. Such player shall remain suspended until his/her case has been reviewed.

MINIMUM PENALTY: Suspension of one year from the point of detection.

MAXIMUM PENALTY: Placed on suspension for life and/or assault charges filed.

2. **NO PLAYER SHALL:** Refuse to abide by officials decisions. Only one representative, who must be designated at pre-game shall be allowed to have any verbal contact with officials. Officials are required to eject player from further play, and report such player to the League Director. Player will remain suspended until his/her case has been reviewed.

MINIMUM PENALTY: Warning by official.

MAXIMUM PENALTY: Removal from game and two game suspension and/or \$20 fine.

3. **NO PLAYER SHALL:** Be guilty of using unnecessarily rough tactics (in game play) against any other person from an opposing team. Officials are required to immediately eject player from further play and report such player to the League Director.

MINIMUM PENALTY: Player ejected from the game.

MAXIMUM PENALTY: Suspension for two games and/or \$20 fine, and placed on probation for one year.

4. **NO PLAYER SHALL:** Make physical or verbal unsportsmanlike contact with any player, monitor or spectator. Officials are required to immediately eject player from further play and report such player to the League Director. Player will remain suspended until his/her case has been reviewed.

MINIMUM PENALTY: Suspension of one (1) year from all Campbell County Parks and Recreation Department adult sports activities.

MAXIMUM PENALTY: Suspension for life and/or assault charges filed.

5. NO PLAYER SHALL: Possess alcohol, drugs, or stimulants or be under the influence of such, or smoke tobacco products on the field of play (within the fences or dugouts - in any school or the Recreation Center). Officials are required to eject such player (give verbal warning first in case of smoking) immediately from further play and report such offense to the League Director.
6. Any player removed from a game must leave the facility (OUT OF SIGHT - OUT OF SOUND) immediately. Failure to do so will result in forfeiture of the game and suspension for three (3) league games for the player.
7. Any player being placed on probation and reported again for violation of the Code of Conduct will be given a minimum penalty of suspension for one (1) year.
8. Participants will be held liable for damages caused by negligence.
9. Teams are responsible for the conduct of their spectators. Failure to attempt to control disruptive spectators may result in forfeiture of the game.
10. Campbell County Parks and Recreation Department has the prerogative of modifying any Player Code of Conduct Rule and/or penalty when deemed appropriate.
