

Official Rules

1. Participants must be currently employed by (or married to an employee or a dependant of an employee) and working for a company in Campbell County, work a minimum of 15 hours per week and 16 years of age or older. (Note: Some events require participants to be 21 years of age.)
2. For an employee's spouse to participate on a Corporate team the employee must participate in at least one event.
3. Participants are encouraged to wear their Corporate Games T-Shirt during competition.
4. Each company must have a "Captain" that is the contact person for changes, messages, information, etc.
5. Protests are permitted for eligibility and game rules only. Protests may not be filed on judgment calls. All protests must be filed immediately and accompanied by a \$25.00 fee. The \$25.00 will be refunded if the protest is allowed. The protest committee is comprised of Parks and Recreation Corporate Games Coordinators.
6. Team captains or coaches are responsible for team check-in with the event coordinator 15 minutes before the start of the event. Participants may be required to provide a company I.D. or driver's license as identification.
7. If a business or corporation has a large number of employees, that business may enter more than one team by paying an additional Corporate team fee. Players may be listed on only one "A" roster.
8. If a player cannot participate, another player currently listed on the team roster may be substituted. A substitute not currently on the roster and must be an employee can pay the \$14 player fee the day of the event to participate. The official team roster and player fee is due by 10 pm on Tuesday, May 3th, 2011 at the Parks and Recreation Department.
9. Corporate "A" and "AA" Division: Winners in each event receive Prizes. The Corporate Games traveling trophy is awarded to the Corporate "A" and "AA" team with the most points at the end of the games. In case of a 1st place tie, the team with the most 1st place finishes will be the winner. The same procedure will be repeated for each place until the tie can be broken.
Corporate "B" Division: Winners in each event receive Prizes.
10. Corporate Games Point System: Points are awarded based on the following:
Team Scoring - 1st - 100 points 2nd - 80 points 3rd - 65 points 4th - 50 points All others - 30 points
All co-ed team sports are worth the following points
1st - 200 points 2nd - 160 points 3rd - 130 points 4th - 100 points All others - 60 points
Minute to win It bonus points - Yes just like the show we will offer a minute to win it challenge at each event for 20 bonus points. Each team will be given the opportunity to have one rep from their team compete in the minute to win it challenge for 20 team points. One winner in each division.
